

#### **NOTICE OF RACE**

The Organising Authority is Sailability South Australia Inc. (SSA) in conjunction with The Port Adelaide Sailing Club (PASC)

The Regatta will be held on the 2<sup>nd</sup> April 2023 on the waters of the Port River adjacent to The PASC, Largs North, South Australia. A map is provided in Addendum 1

#### 1. Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024 and the Australia Sailing (AS) prescriptions and Special Regulations Part 2 for Off the Beach Boats. Except as amended by this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2 Approval for changes to nominated on the entry form Crew nominated on the Entry Form may be given by the Race Committee if a written request including the reason for the change is submitted at the first reasonable opportunity
- 1.3 **Rule 2 Fair Sailing** shall be respected by all competitors in consideration of the varying nature of the other competitor's abilities.
- 1.4 Rule 20 Room to Tack at an Obstruction is changed so that sailors need not hail in response but they must if they can or they may signal by any other means available. This changes Rule 20.2.
  - Commercial vessels in the shipping channel shall be considered to be an obstruction.
- 1.5 **Rule 40 Personal Flotation Devices** is changed to include; Competitors shall wear an approved Lifejacket at all times whilst afloat, on pontoons or on gangways during the period of the event including any training and activities outside of scheduled race times.
- 1.6 **Rule 41 Outside Help** is changed as follows;
  - In all Classes, Outside Assistance is permitted for the purpose of safety.
  - This assistance includes the reefing and un-reefing of sails, bailing, assisting a grounded vessel and radio assistance.
- 1.7 **Rule 61.1 Informing the Protestee** is changed so that sailors need not hail "Protest" or fly a red flag but they must if they can or signal by any other means available.
- 1.8 **Rule 87 Changes to Rules** is changed as follows:
  - There will be a minimum combined two person weight of 100 kg. for the 303 Class.
  - Weights, including lead, sand, water or similar materials in a sealed container up to a maximum of 15kg may be used and shall be secured in the boat at all times whilst racing to meet this requirement. Such weights shall be available for inspection.
  - Competitors are responsible for supplying their own weights.

#### 2. Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 Entry for Skippers is open to any member of SSA, or any other Club affiliated with Sailability Australia, with a recognised physical, intellectual or visual disability, to the satisfaction of SSA. And shall; Also be a member of a Sailing or Yacht Club affiliated with Australian Sailing.
- 2.2 Crews shall be a member of a Sailing or Yacht Club affiliated with Australian Sailing.


  Note; Membership of an affiliated club is required for the current AS insurance coverage policy.
- 2.3 Eligible boats shall enter by completing the Entry and Indemnity Form and the Boat and Pontoon information Form and sending them together with the required fee to; The PASC Sailability SA Regatta by Monday 6th March 2023.
- 2.4 Entries that are incomplete or late may not be accepted.











#### 3. Fees

- 3.1 The Regatta entry fee is AUD \$30.00 including GST.
- 3.2 The entry fee shall be paid to PASC SSA Regatta. Payment details are on the "Payments Form"

#### 4. Classes

4.1 The regatta will be sailed in;

2.3 Class - Single handed303 Class - Double handedLiberty Class - Single handed

- 4.2 The Organising Authority may alter, amalgamate or divide any Class.
- 4.3 Competitors who do not have their own boat may arrange provision of a boat through their local Sailability group.

#### 5. Schedule of Events

- 5.1 Boats and crews shall register at the PASC between 0900 and 1000 hours on the 2<sup>nd</sup> April.
- 5.2 Boats and equipment shall be available for inspection at the PASC between 0900 and 1000 hours on the  $2^{nd}$  April, and shall be at any time during the Regatta.

- 5.4 Three races are scheduled.
- 5.5 No more than three races will be sailed on any one day.
- 5.6 No more than two races will be sailed back to back.
- 5.7 No warning signal shall be made after 1600 hours on Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup> April 2023.

#### 6. Sailing Instructions

The Sailing Instructions will be available prior to registration.

All Notices, Instructions and Forms will also be available from your club's Sailability Coordinator or via email from the Event Coordinators.

#### 7. Racing Area

The racing area will be on the waters of the Port River adjacent to the PASC, South Australia. A map is provided in Addendum 1.

#### 8. The Courses

Courses will be of windward / leeward or triangular format and shall be posted on the Official Notice Board at the PASC.

#### 9. Penalty System


Rules 44.1 and 44.2 are changed. The Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by a One-Turn Penalty.











#### 10. Scoring System

- 10.1 The Low Point Scoring System, shall apply.
- 10.2 At least one race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 10.3 A boat's Regatta score will be the total of her race scores.

#### 11. Safety

- 11.1 All competitors shall wear an approved Life-Jacket which is in good condition and in accordance with the specifications issued or approved by a national authority or standards organisation at all times whilst afloat, on pontoons or on gangways during the period of the event including any training and activities outside of scheduled race times.
- 11.2 The "Commercial Vessels Special Rule" as detailed in the Sailing Instructions shall apply.

#### 12. Support Boats and Coaches

- 12.1 Team managers, coaches and other support personnel shall register by completing a registration form available at registration before 1000 hours on 2<sup>nd</sup> April 2023.
- 12.2 Approved Support Boats shall keep at least 25m clear of the course area during racing, except when asked to assist by the race committee.
- 12.3 All support boats shall display an identification flag.

#### 13. Prizes

- 13.1 Prizes will be awarded for First, Second & Third Place in Classes with three or more entries.
- 13.2 The Deirdre Schahinger Perpetual Team Trophy.
- 13.3 Other prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the Organising Authority.

#### 14. Communication

- 14.1 Whilst on the water, a boat shall not carry equipment capable of making radio transmissions or receiving radio transmissions except for equipment approved by the organising authority. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones or devices.
- 14.2 Servo assisted sailors are exempted from 14.1 for the purpose of safety.

#### 15. Advertising


- 15.1 Advertising will be as defined by ISAF regulation 20.
- 15.2 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.
- 15.3 The organising authority reserves the right to refuse advertising by a boat or competitor when it is in conflict with an event sponsor or the laws of the South Australian or Australian Governments.











#### 16. Rights to use Name and Likeness

In participating in this Regatta, a participant automatically grants to the Organising Authority and the Sponsors the right in perpetuity to make, use and show from time to time and at their discretion any motion pictures, still pictures and live or recorded television and other reproductions of him or her during the period of this Regatta and in all material related to the said Regatta without compensation.

#### 17. Disclaimer of Liability

- 17.1 Competitors participate in the Regatta entirely at their own risk.
- 17.2 Attention is drawn to Rule 3, Decision to Race, which states; "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone."
- 17.3 Competitors shall accept that their participation in this Regatta is at their exclusive risk in every respect. By way of entry in this Regatta competitors shall indemnify the Organising Authorities.
- 17.4 The Organising Authorities, the Host Club, their Officers, Members, Servants and Agents accept no responsibility in respect of loss of life, personal injury or loss or damage to property which may be sustained by reason of their participation or intended participation in this Regatta or howsoever arising in connection with this Regatta.

#### 18. Insurance

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of AUD \$20 million or the equivalent. All owners / competitors who sign the Entry and Indemnity Forms are deemed to have made a declaration that they hold such cover.



The racing area will be on the waters of the Port River Between # 42 Beacon and the Northern end of # 29 Wharf.




