

Port Adelaide Sailing Club (PASC) Season 2020-2021



Notice of Race

RULES

- ❖ The yacht racing conducted by the PASC Sailing Committee will be governed by the rules as defined in The Australian Sailing Blue e-Book Racing Rules of Sailing. (AS RRS) 2017-2020;
- ❖ Rules and regulations that are specific to the conduct of racing at PASC are detailed in the PASC Sailing Instructions (version 2 dated 12/10/20) and must be followed;
- ❖ Where there is conflict between this Notice of Race (NOR) and the SI's, the SI's will take precedence.

ELIGIBILITY TO RACE

- ❖ To be eligible to participate in any race managed by the PASC sailing committee the competing skipper must:
 - be a financial member of PASC;
 - submit an Australian Sailing special regulations equipment form;
 - submit a PASC nomination to Race form;
 - complete the PASC race sign on sheet available at the sailing desk prior to the commencement of each race;
 - have submitted insurance and registration documents to the PASC secretary (refer below).

FEES

- ❖ A season entry fee for all races as detailed in the schedule contained in the PASC SI's is set at \$175. If skippers wish to enter their boat on a casual basis a fee of \$15 will be charged;
- ❖ Casual entrants are to indicate their entry into the race as a casual on the PASC race sign on sheet;
- ❖ Racing fees will be debited to member's accounts and an invoice will be forwarded by the PASC Treasurer.

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- ❖ Sailing instructions will be available at the PASC sailing desk and PASC website prior to commencement.

COURSES

- ❖ All races are conducted in the Port River and an area within the vicinity of the Outer Harbour area;
- ❖ Courses will be posted on the day of the race on the sailing notice board.

PRIZES AND AWARDS

- ❖ Prizes and or trophies will be only be given to "financial members" of the PASC
- ❖ All perpetual trophy races are part of a race series and only series entrants are eligible to win the trophy;
- ❖ Extra prizes and sponsorship prizes are awarded at the discretion of the PASC Management Committee.

INSURANCE AND BOAT REGISTRATION

- ❖ All boats participating in races conducted by the PASC Sailing Committee must have current South Australian Boat Registration and current third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$10,000,000;
- ❖ Documents providing proof of registration and insurance must be supplied to the PASC Secretary prior to the commencement of a race or a race series.

DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- ❖ Competitors participating in a race or race series do so entirely at their own risk. ***See AS RRS Rule 4, Decision to Race, "***
- ❖ The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage, personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the race.
