23rd - 26th JAN 2021

RULES

- ❖ The yacht racing conducted by the PASC Sailing Committee will be governed by the rules as defined in The Australian Sailing Blue e-Book Racing Rules of Sailing. (AS RRS) 2021-2024. This document is available from the AS website;
- ❖ Rules and regulations that are specific to the conduct of racing at PASC are detailed in the PASC Sailing Instructions for the (Australia Day Long Weekend Event) and must be followed;
- ❖ Where there is conflict between this Notice of Race (NOR) and the SI's, the SI's will take precedence.

ELIGIBILITY TO RACE

- ❖ To be eligible to participate in any race managed by the PASC sailing committee the competing skipper must:
 - be a financial member of a Yacht Club;
 - have submitted an Australian Sailing special regulations equipment form;
 - submit a PASC nomination to Race form, to be received no later than 1700hrs on Friday 22nd Jan 2021;
 - complete the PASC race sign on sheet available at the sailing desk prior to the commencement of the event or email the PASC Sailing Committee of intentions to "sign on";
 - have appropriate documentation for insurance, SA Govt Boating Registration, category documentation (min of cat 6).

FEES

- ❖ \$15 per race;
- ❖ Fees will be invoiced by forwarded by the PASC Treasurer and forwarded by email.

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- ❖ Sailing instructions will be available at the PASC sailing desk and PASC website prior to the race.

COURSES

PRIZES AND AWARDS

- ❖ Prizes and trophies (including the Patrick Robbins Memorial) will be awarded at the scheduled PASC presentations night.

INSURANCE AND BOAT REGISTRATION

- ❖ All boats participating in the Australia Day Event must hold a current South Australian Boat Registration and current third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$10,000,000;
- ❖ Documents providing proof of registration and insurance must be supplied to the PASC if requested.

DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- ❖ Competitors participating in a race or race series do so entirely at their own risk. ***See AS RRS Rule 3, Decision to Race, "***
- ❖ The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage, personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the race.
